Our Accomplishments in 2018

- Earned the Hospital Improvement Innovation Network (HIIN) Award from the New Mexico Hospital Association for two years of performance improvement evidenced by measurements of quality and patient safety.
- Recognized for significant improvement in decreasing the number of patient falls and hospital readmissions. One of 15 New Mexico hospitals recognized for excellence during the 2016-2018 phase of HIIN, a program supported by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

Dr. Dan C. Trigg Memorial Hospital is a county-owned facility that has been managed by Presbyterian Healthcare Services since 1978. Dr. Dan C. Trigg Memorial Hospital and Presbyterian Healthcare Services operate a hospital, primary care and specialty care clinics, outpatient rehabilitation services, and home health and hospice services in Quay County. Dr. Dan C. Trigg Memorial Hospital is one of nine hospitals run by Presbyterian, which also has a statewide health plan and a growing multi-specialty medical group.

- We provide the only emergency department between Albuquerque and Amarillo, Texas, staffed 24/7 by an on-site physician.
- We operate clinics in Tucumcari and Logan.
- We provide outpatient behavioral health programs for senior adults.
- We provide access to radiology services, including MRI, CT, ultrasound, mammography and bone density testing, interpreted by Radiology Associates of Albuquerque.
- We house a full-service TriCore laboratory serving both inpatients and outpatients

Serving Our Community

In 2018:

- We employed 77 people. All of the physicians, nurses and advanced practice clinicians at our clinics live in local communities.
- We provided more than \$6.2 million in employee salaries, wages and benefits.
- We provided more than \$5.3 million in community benefit (including financial assistance).
- Our 15 volunteers contributed a total of 1,208 hours.
- Leaders visited Tucumcari Elementary School for Day of Service.
- Hosted third-grade tours during Hospital Week.
- Sponsored the Quay County Fun Run and provided cookies and cocoa after the Christmas Light Parade.
- Partnered with the Quay County Health Council for a wellness fair in April.
- The Dr. Dan C. Trigg Memorial Hospital Board of Trustees provided governance, leadership and direction for the hospital, clinics and emergency medical services.
