What is the overall deductible ?	In-Network: \$500 /Individual / \$1,000 /Family Out-of-Network: \$1,000 /Individual / \$2,000 /Family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. preventive care is covered before you meet your deductible .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive care without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
