Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	\$2500/Individual / \$5000/Family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> ?	Yes. <a href="#">Preventive care</a> and any benefit where there is no charge (except for HDHPs) are covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. For example, this plan covers certain <a href="#">preventive care</a> without <a href="#">cost sharing</a> and before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a> .
