Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible ?	\$2500/Individual / \$5000/Family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care and any benefit where there is no charge (except for HDHPs) are covered before you meet your deductible .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive care without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . See a list of covered preventive services at www.healthcare.gov/coverage/preventive-care-benefits .
Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?	\$7900 Individual / \$15800 Family	The out of pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit ?	Premiums, balance billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out of pocket limit .
Will you pay less if you use a network provider ?	Yes. See www.phs.org or call 1-800-356-2219 for a list of participating providers.	This plan uses a provider network . You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network . Do you need a referral to see a specialist ?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral.
