



## Lincoln County Medical Center Report to the Community 2015



Lincoln County Medical Center is a county-owned facility that has been leased and managed by Presbyterian Healthcare Services since 1972. This partnership is dedicated to improving the health of individuals, families and communities in Ruidoso and Lincoln County. Presbyterian Healthcare Services, through Lincoln County Medical Center, operates a hospital, two hospital-based primary care clinics and a specialty clinic, three rural clinics, and a countywide ambulance service in Lincoln County. Lincoln County Medical Center is one of eight hospitals run by Presbyterian, which also has a statewide health plan and a growing multi-specialty medical group.

## Investing in Your Healthcare

- Successfully recruited five new providers to Lincoln County, expanding access to healthcare for our community.
- Implemented an outpatient specialty clinic in March 2015, offering hospital-based infusions.
- Purchased more than \$600,000 in medical equipment for multiple departments:
  - \$323,575 for radiology
  - \$19,720 for the operating room
  - \$73,666 for UV disinfection
  - \$104,291 for our medical, surgical, and obstetrics inpatient care units, and our inpatient Intensive Care Unit (ICU)
  - \$82,083 for physical therapy and pulmonology
  - \$9,733 for hospital maintenance

## Our Accomplishments

- Recognized by The Joint Commission as a “Top Performer for Key Quality Measures” for the fourth year in a row.
- The Presbyterian Medical Group family medicine clinic at Lincoln County Medical Center was the only clinic in New Mexico having met or exceeded 90 percent childhood immunization rates for the twelfth year in a row.



## Serving Our Community

### In 2015:

- We employed more than 265 people and generated hundreds of additional jobs in the community.
- We provided more than \$20.5 million in employee salaries, wages, and benefits.
- We provided more than \$4.4 million in community benefit (including financial assistance).
- Our 65 auxiliaries volunteered a total of 11,620 hours. As in years past, they donated approximately \$10,000 in scholarship education for nurses and support programs for the staff and community.
- Between 2007 and 2015, our auxiliaries have donated \$804,000 toward improving our healthcare facilities and services, for a total of \$2 million since its inception.
- We supported community health initiatives, including Altrusa's Low Cost Mammogram program, Run for the B.E.A.C.H., Steppin' Into a Better You Health Fair, and other events.
- The Lincoln County Medical Center Board of Trustees, comprised of community members, provided governance, leadership, and direction for Lincoln County Medical Center, our clinics, and EMS.
