Presbyterian Española Hospital is an acute-care hospital that has been managed by Presbyterian Healthcare Services since 1977. The hospital serves a diverse population of patients from the Española Valley, Rio Arriba county, northern New Mexico, Santa Fe, and Los Alamos. Over the years, the hospital has expanded to meet the growing and changing needs of its patients. It offers a wide range of healthcare services, including inpatient care, ambulatory and surgical services, and emergency care as well as primary and specialty care services. Presbyterian Española Hospital is one of eight hospitals run by Presbyterian, which has a statewide health plan and a growing multi-specialty group.

In 2015:

- We employed approximately 375 people, including 30 providers.
