

Presbyterian Hospital Parking Lot Construction

The Presbyterian Hospital entrance and parking areas are undergoing construction to improve parking and move the main entrance to Spruce Street. These improvements to the Presbyterian Hospital campus have been planned for several years. We were able to coordinate our construction project with the City of Albuquerque's ART (Albuquerque Rapid Transit) project to minimize the impact on patients and visitors. The work is expected to continue throughout 2017. During this time, we ask that patients and visitors allow extra time for parking and getting to appointments on the Presbyterian Hospital campus.

Once complete, Presbyterian Hospital will have:

- A new main entrance, located on the corner of Central Ave. and Spruce St.
- A new park area near the front entrance, which will include a gazebo and eating areas for patients, visitors and staff
- Safer handicapped parking, closer to the front entrance
- Improved traffic flow
- Continued valet parking

We appreciate your patience as we undergo construction to improve our parking lots and main entrance. To assist our patients and visitors during this time, valet parking will be available and parking attendants will be on hand to guide visitors to available parking spaces.
